


Peer Empowerment Programme for Achievement of Migrant Women

Peer Empowerment Programme for Achievement of Migrant Women (PEPA) is a two-year project designed to empower migrant women by providing opportunities to support their peers in learning and social activities, and to volunteer in their communities.

The project will benefit all kinds of migrant women; it has been designed to be especially beneficial to those with lower educational attainment, on low incomes, socially isolated, or in vulnerable circumstances.

Peer support and volunteering have been shown to significantly improve migrant women's



- outcomes for integration

The partners distributed responsibilities and tasks according to the project proposal, discussed and clarified the framework for the project milestones, Quality Assurance and Risk Management Strategy, Dissemination Strategy and database of stakeholders, dealt with communication and transparency to create the necessary tools to guarantee good communication among the partners.


